- Address any other PFM reform related matter that may be brought to its attention.
- The Group may co-opt any member/professional for its assistance to achieve objectives.
- The chair of the Group, in consultation with team Lead PFM-SPP shall schedule the timelines for regular meetings of the group through Economic Reform Unit Finance Department, Government of Sindh, Karachi.


