The Government of Sindh has been pleased to nominate Commissioner Sukkur, Larkana and Hyderabad as Focal Persons, for coordinating cross border population movement and bordering areas/houses coverage during campaign with Commissioners of Punjab and Balochistan, having districts bordering with Sindh.

**Terms of Reference:**

- i. To coordinate any cross border population movements to ensure vaccination of children moving with families on seasonal harvesting, local religious pilgrimage, brick kiln workers, etc.
- ii. Direct the concerned districts in their jurisdiction for appropriate planning and implementation of specific strategies including PTP (Transit vaccination Points vaccinating children on the move) as well as population movement between bordering villages/tehsils and their proper coverage, during campaigns.
- iii. Develop specific micro plan for polio teams for incorporating the route plan and social profile for proper follow-up of children and tracking missed children.
- iv. Further necessary coordination with EOC Sindh, ERU Sukkur etc.
