Subject: VISITS ABROAD BY PAKISTAN DELEGATIONS INCLUDING OFFICERS/OFFICIALS AND DIGNATIRES.

Reference Cabinet Division's U.O. of even number dated 29th September, 2015 on the subject noted above. It has once again been observed that the Federal and Provincial officers/officials are not following "Instructions on visits abroad" in letter and spirit with respect to interaction with foreigners or undertaking official visits abroad. It has been pointed out that two delegations of different departments proceeded abroad without intimating the Ministry of Foreign Affairs which created an embarrassing situation for Pakistani Missions abroad and adversely affected their working.

2. In pursuance of Cabinet Division's instructions on visits abroad, all cases of visits abroad require clearance from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Moreover, the summaries containing proposal for seeking approval of the Prime Minister on visits abroad should be routed in the following order:-

1. Secretary, Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
2. Secretary, Finance Division (Where government funding, is any way involved);
3. Secretary, Cabinet Division; and
4. Secretary to the Prime Minister.

3. The aforesaid instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.


